

Summary of Statistics Covering January- March 2010 Quarter

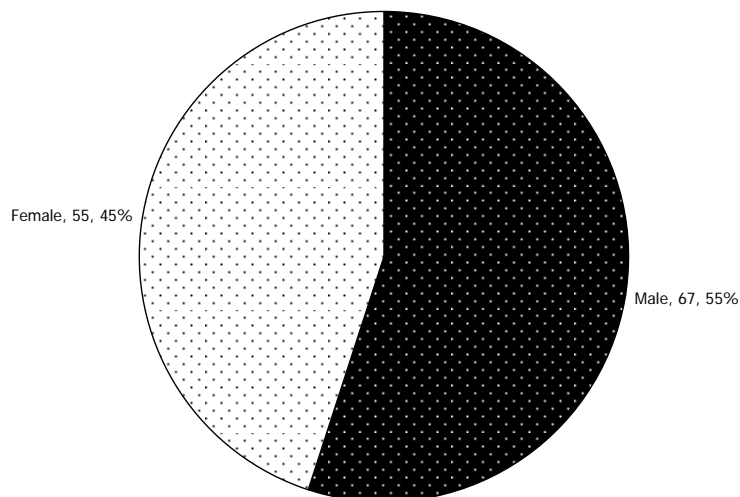


Figure 1. – January to March 10 quarter registrations by gender.

Total of 122 new registrations were received during January to March 2010 quarter. 45% of these were females and 55% males.

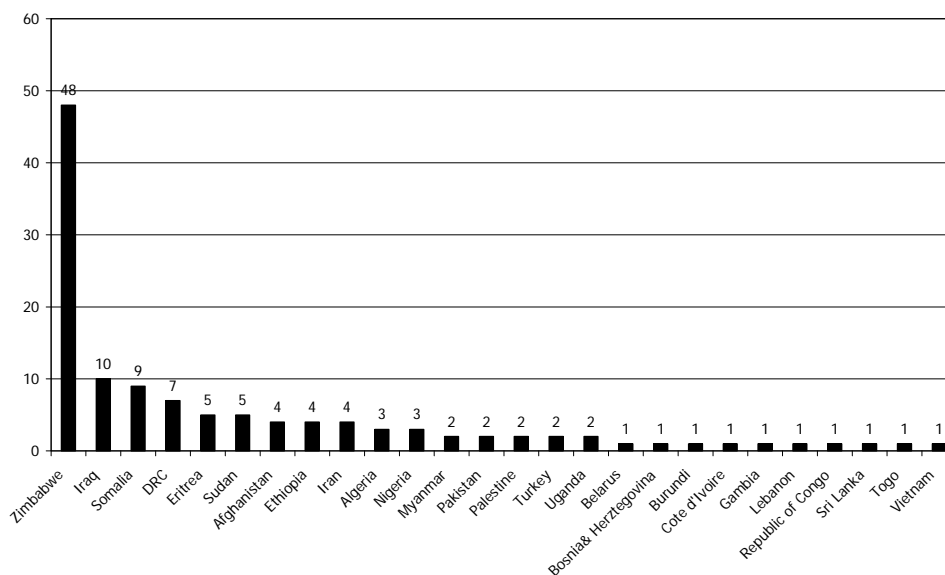


Figure 2. - Shows country of origin (26 nationalities) for new registrants in January- March 2010 quarter.

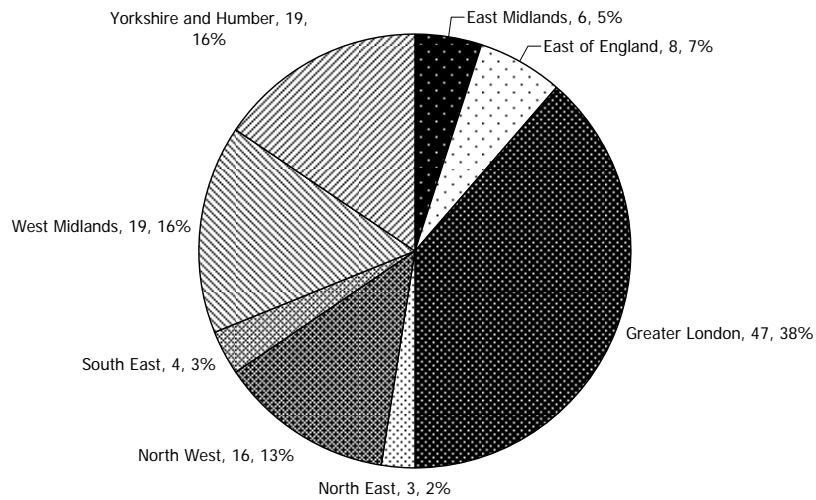


Figure 3. - Regions where new registrations were received during January-March 10 quarter.

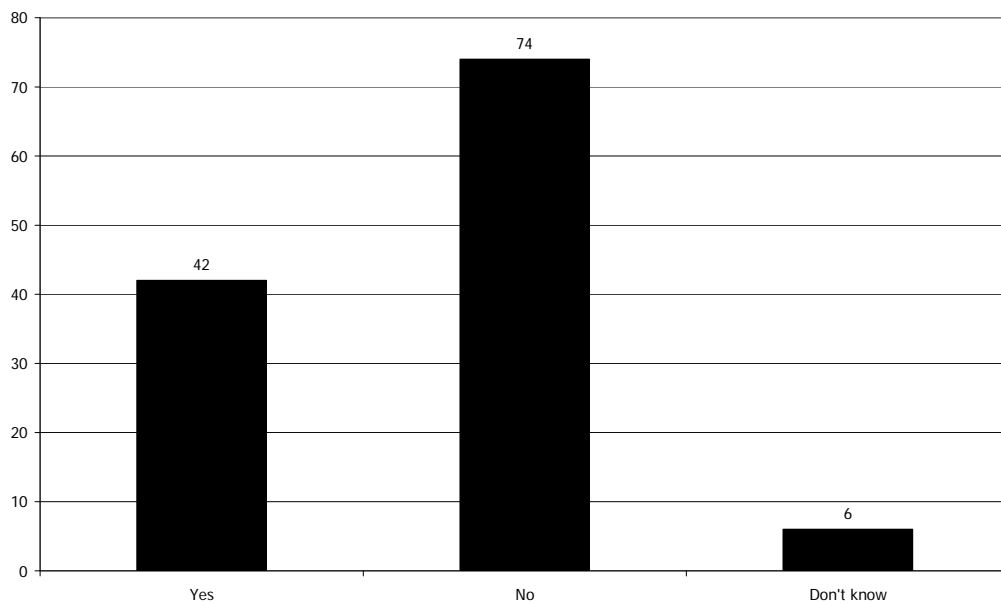


Figure 4. - Teaching qualifications before arriving in UK.

From the 122 quarterly registrants 42 clients have a teaching qualification from overseas (Fig.4.).

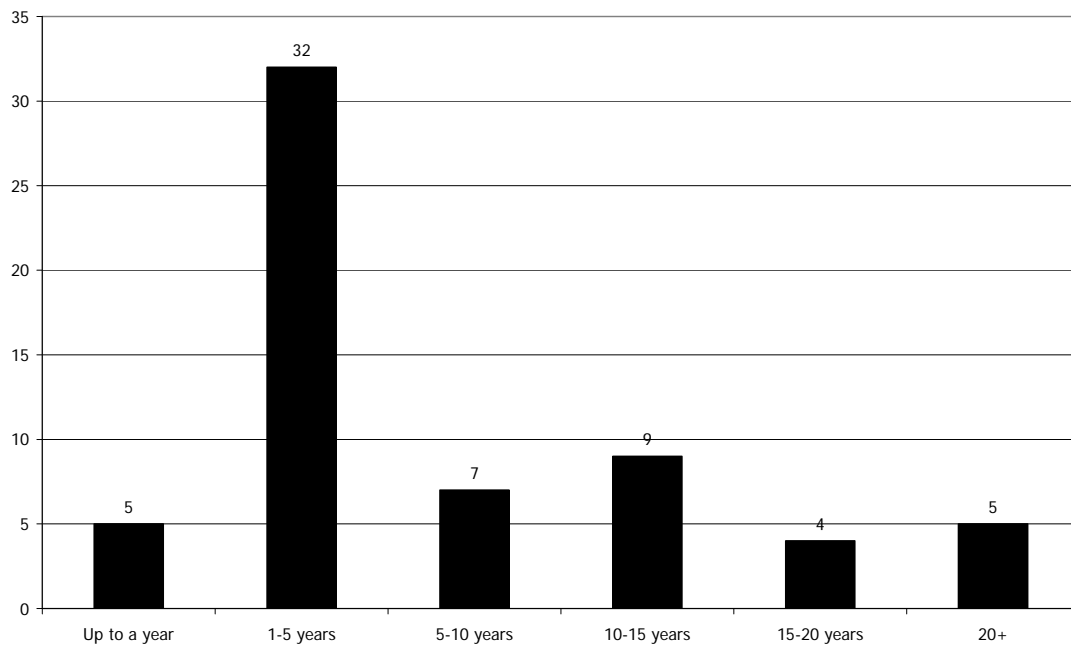


Figure 5. – Length of overseas teaching experience of the 62 teachers out of 122 registered on the database during January- March 10 quarter.

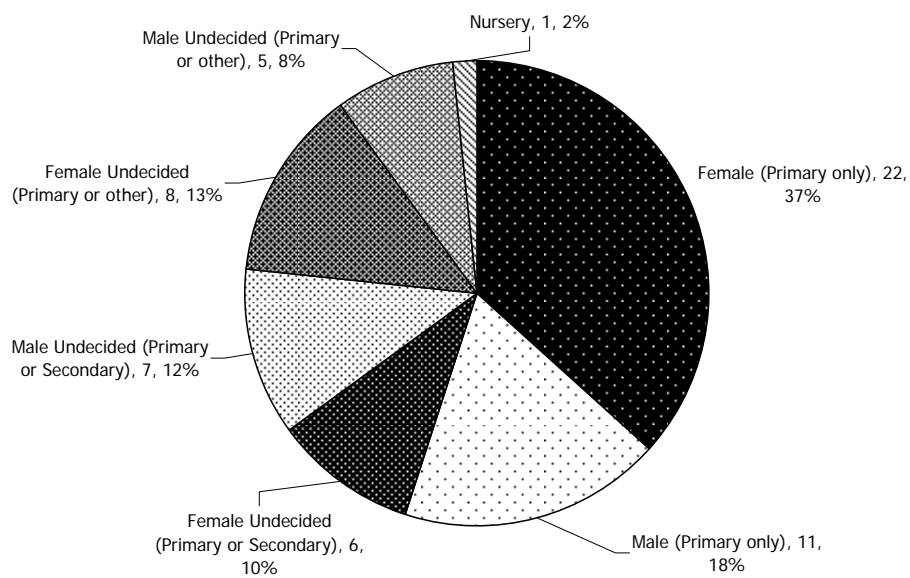


Figure 6a. - Numbers of teachers interested in teaching at primary level this quarter (out of 122). 20 undecided teachers also appear under secondary numbers.

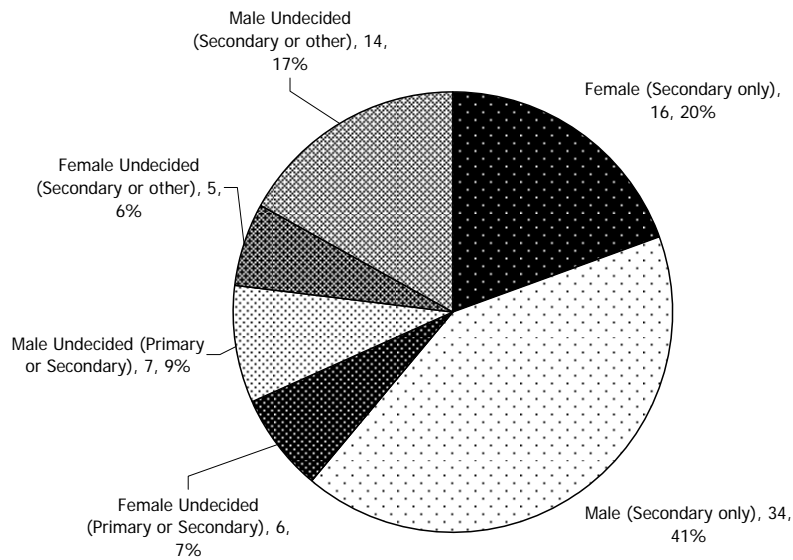


Figure 6b. - Numbers of teachers interested in teaching at secondary level this quarter (out of 122). 20 undecided teachers also appear under primary numbers.

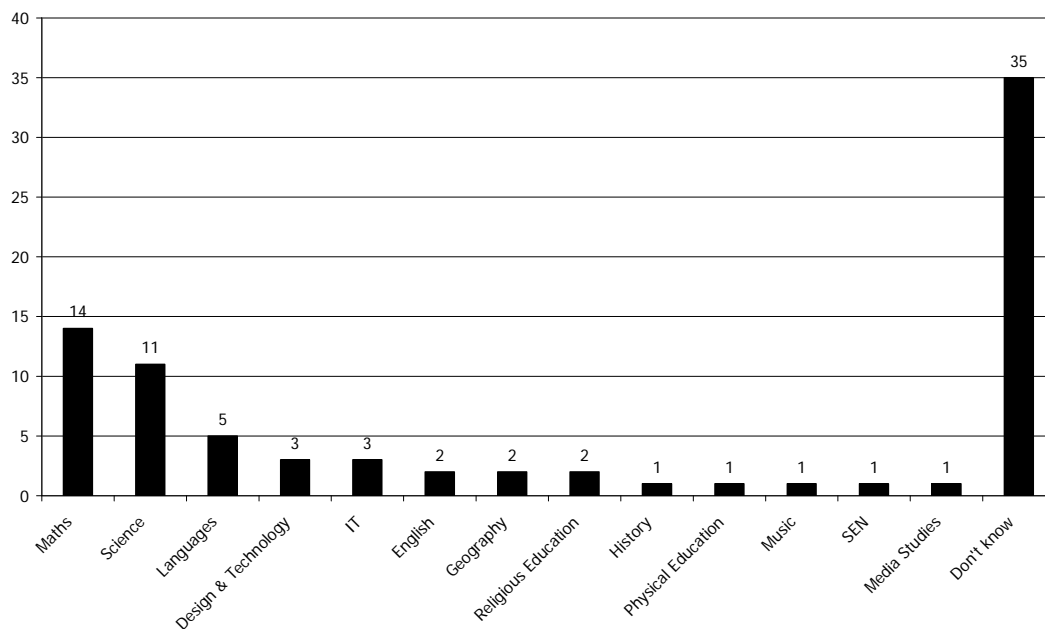


Figure 7. - First choice subject specialism of secondary teachers registered during January-March 10 quarter.

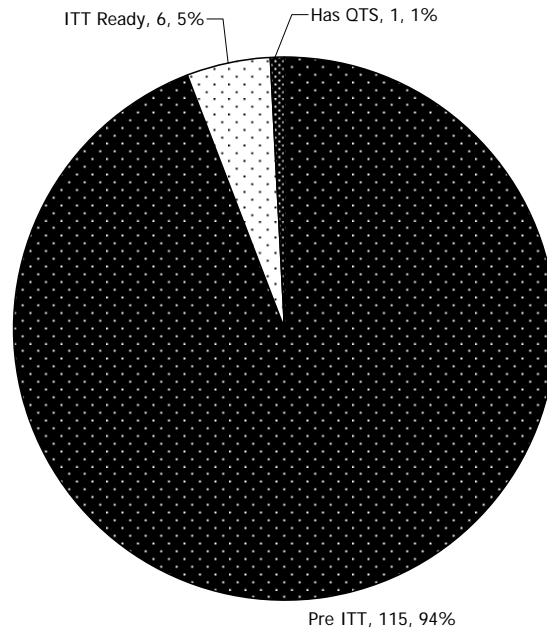


Figure 8. - Levels of ITT preparedness of clients registered during January- March 10 at the time of the registration.

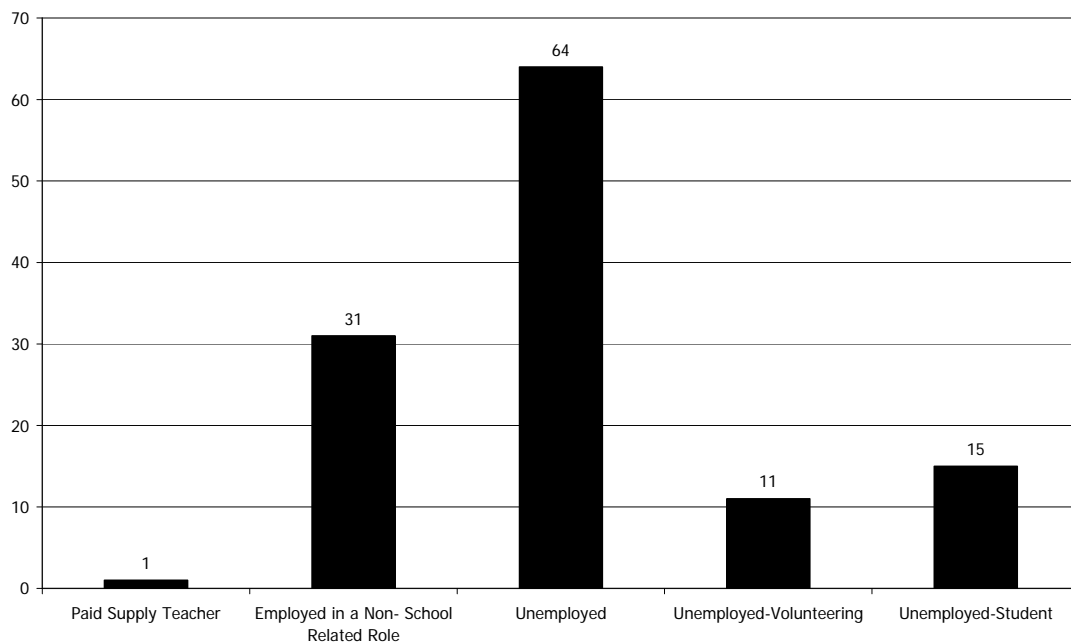


Figure 9. – Quarterly registrants' employment situation at the time of registration.

Project Support and Activities Delivered During the January-March 2010 Quarter

- Total of 137 clients received information, advice and guidance (IAG) on the routes into teaching.
- Total of 51 UK NARIC overseas qualification assessments were arranged for the clients.
- 99 clients were referred to other organisations for further information and advice.
- 43 clients attended an information event on the routes into teaching through the project.
- The project helped 28 clients to get access to a placement and five clients find an observation place in schools.
- During the January- March 2010 quarter 11 clients received employment preparation support and three clients were referred for English Language support.
- Total of six mentoring relationships were formed during the first quarter of the year.
