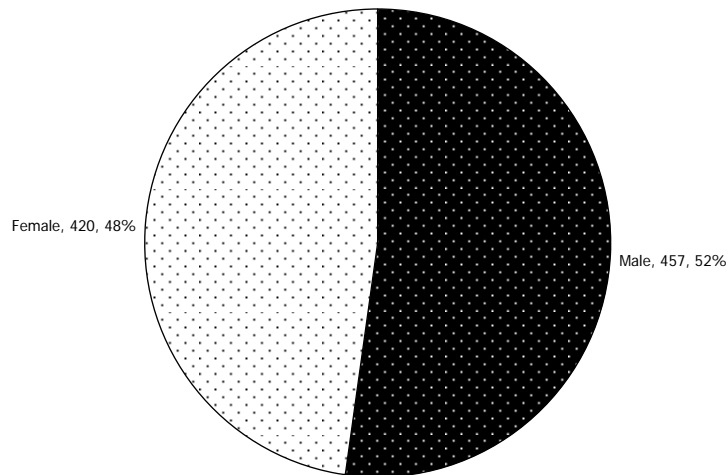


Figure 1. - Total registrations by gender by the end of December 09.

- The total number of clients registered on the national database to date is 877.

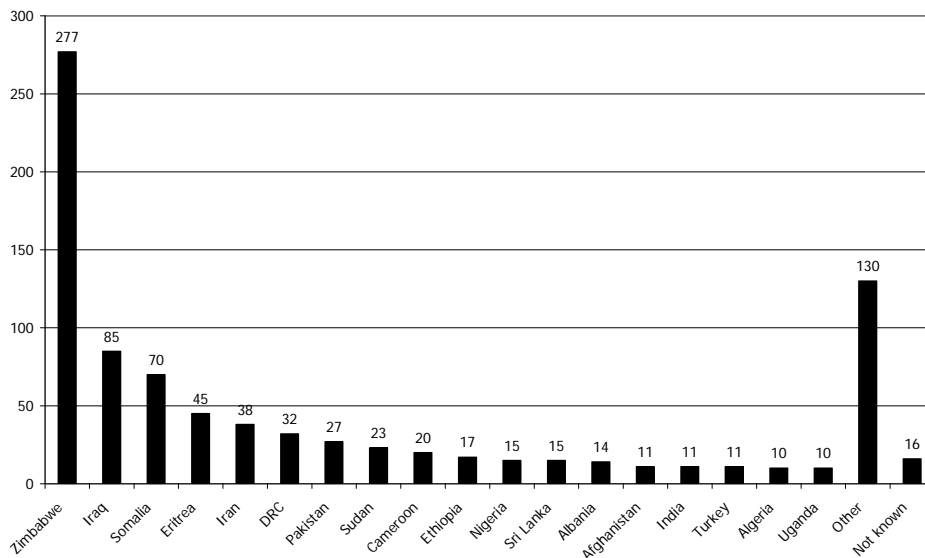


Figure 2. - Top 18 of nationalities registered on the National database as of March 2010.

- The 877 clients on the database come from 60 different nationalities. The three biggest nationality groups remain as Zimbabwe- 277 clients, Iraq- 85 clients and Somalia- 70 clients.

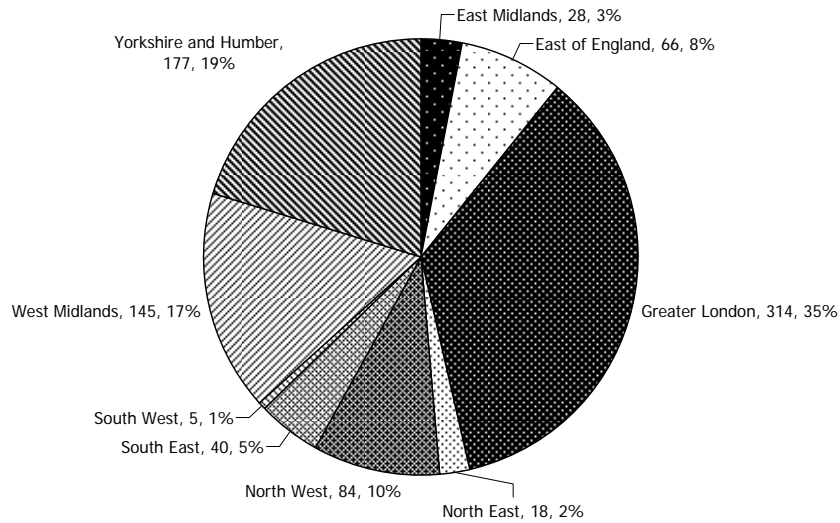


Figure 3. - Current whereabouts of registered refugee teachers as of December 09 (by region in numbers and by percentage).

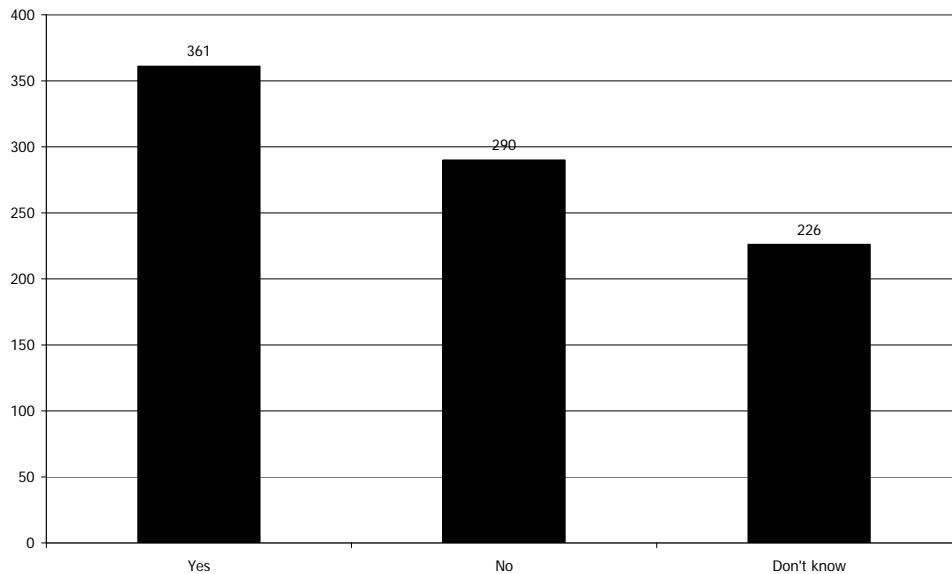


Figure 4. - Teaching qualifications before arriving in UK.

- Of the clients on the database 361 have a teaching qualification from overseas (Fig.4.).

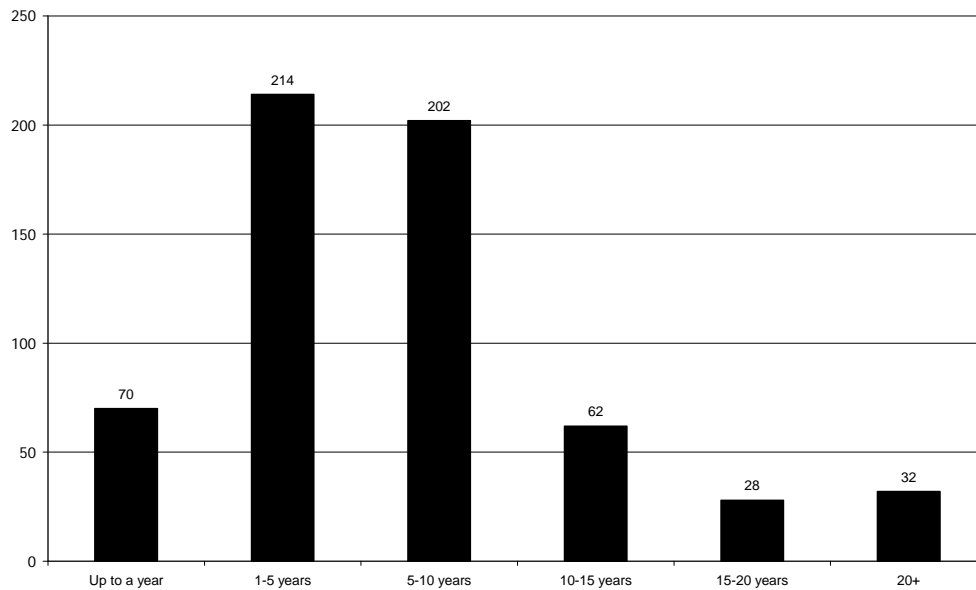


Figure 5. – Length of overseas teaching experience of the 608 out of 877 teachers registered on the database.

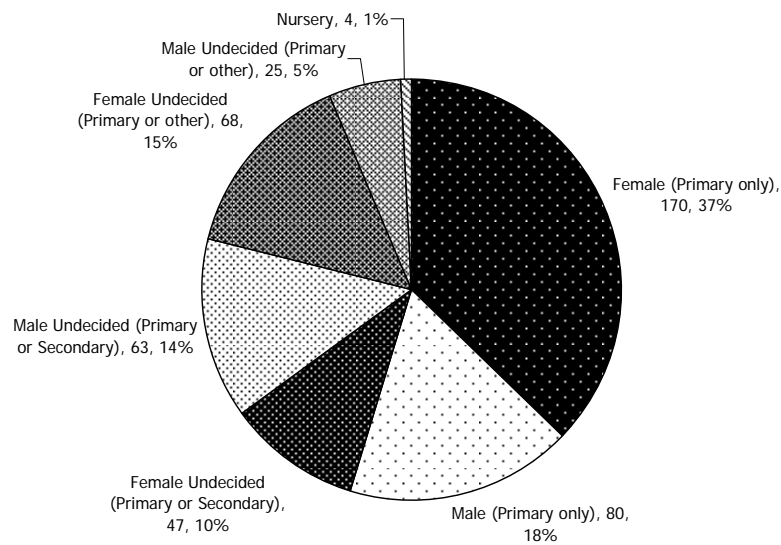


Figure 6a. - Numbers of teachers interested in teaching at primary level registered on the database as a whole (877). 110 undecided teachers also appear under secondary numbers.

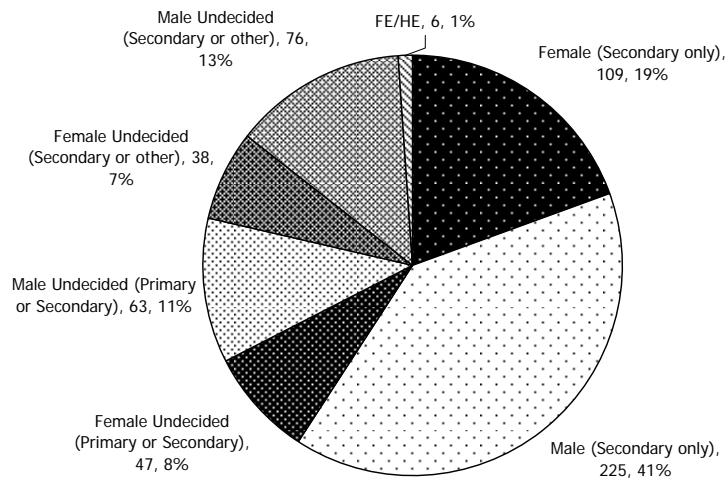


Figure 6b. - Numbers of teachers interested in teaching at secondary level registered on the database as a whole (877). 110 undecided teachers also appear under primary numbers.

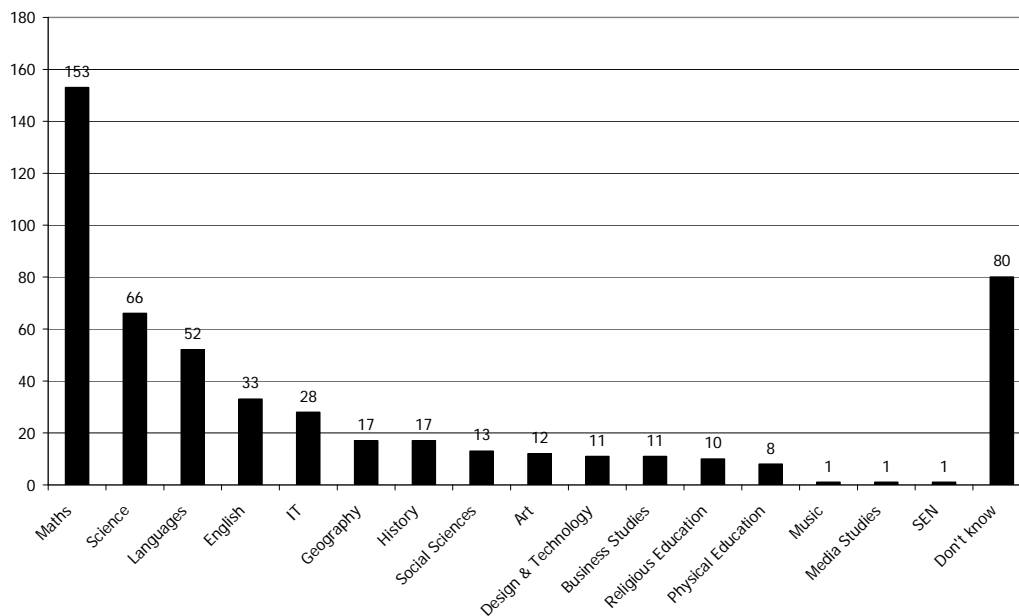


Figure 7. - First choice subject specialism of secondary teachers registered on the database by end of March 2010.

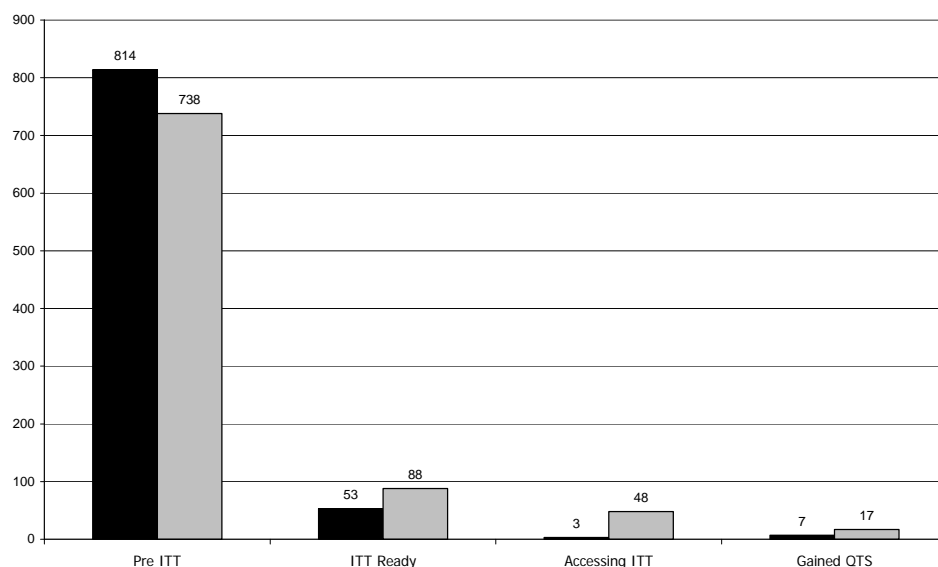


Figure 8. - Levels of ITT preparedness of all clients registered on the database. Black indicates the ITT preparedness of the clients at the time of their registration and grey indicates their current ITT preparedness.

- Since registering with the project 10 clients have gained Qualified Teacher Status (QTS). 7 clients already had QTS at the time of registration and total of 17 clients now have QTS.
- Total of 48 clients have now secured a place on Initial Teacher Training (ITT) courses.
- 88 clients who were recognised as pre ITT at the time of registration are now ready to apply for ITT courses (ITT ready).

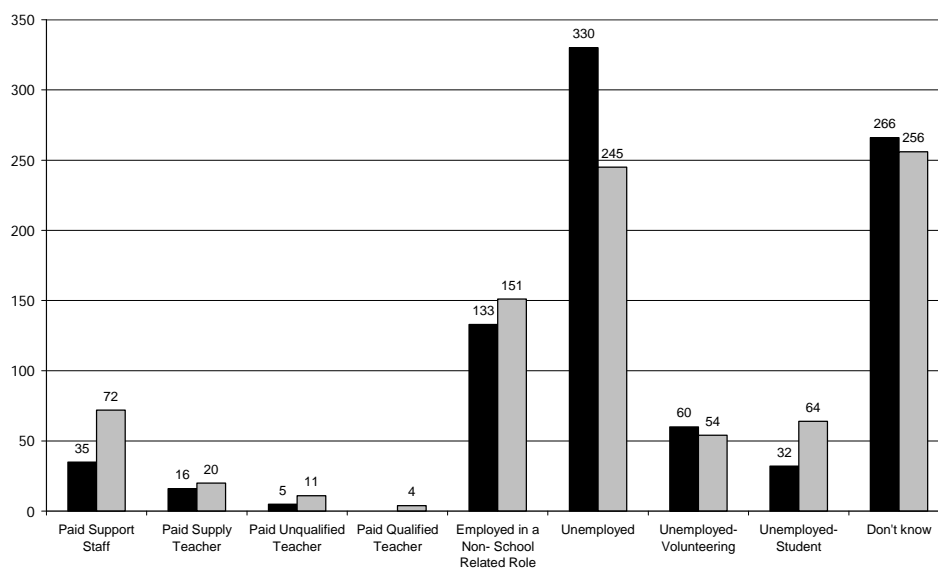


Figure 9. – Registrants' employment situation at the time of registration compared to the current employment situation. Black indicates the clients' employment situation at the time of registration and grey indicates their current employment situation.

Project Support Offered and Activities Delivered

- To date 455 clients have received information, advice and guidance (IAG) on the routes into teaching.
- Total number of UK NARIC overseas qualification assessments offered to clients since to date is now 306.
- All in all 304 clients have been referred to other organisations for further information and advice.
- 158 clients have now attended an information event through the project and total of 50 clients have attended a familiarisation course through the project.
- 92 clients have had access to a placement and 14 clients have found an observation place in schools through the project.
- To date 34 clients in total have now received employment preparation support and 16 clients in total have been referred for English language support by the project.
- Total of six mentoring relationships are up and running through the project.

Client progress

- Since Nov 2008 a total of 51 people have secured paid employment within schools
 - 37 people have secured paid support staff positions
 - 4 people have secured paid supply teaching roles
 - 6 people have secured paid unqualified teaching roles
 - And 4 people have secured paid qualified teaching positions(a further 18 have found paid employment outside of the school sector)
 - 32 people have now become students.
