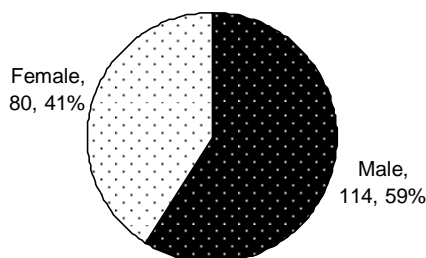


National Refugee Teachers Database Summary

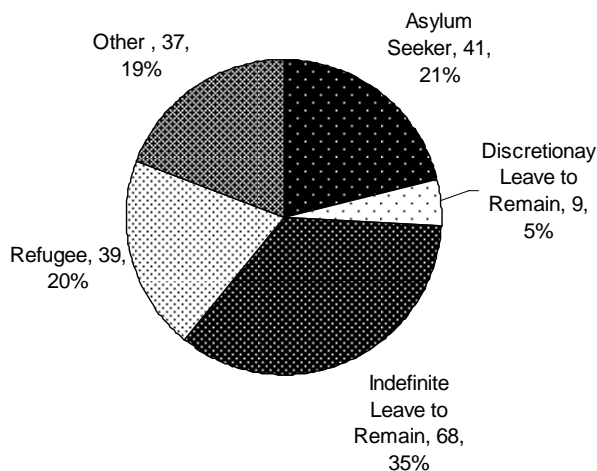
- 194 people registered up to October 2007. This shows an increase by 57% in the number of registrations received in the last 8 months. Females now account for 41% of all registrations.

Gender Of All Teachers Registered



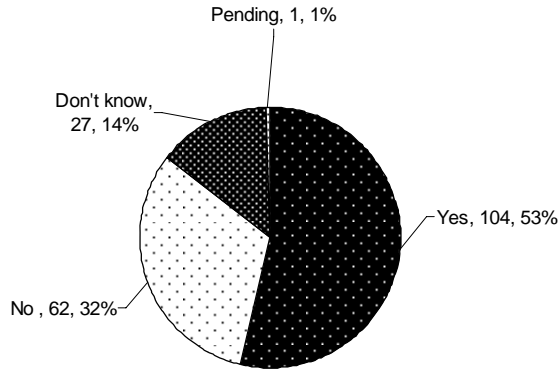
- 21% of registrants have stated that they are claiming asylum at the time of registration, and 60% hold either Indefinite or Discretionary Leave to Remain or have refugee status. 37% of registrants have selected 'other' as their immigration status and these are either EU/EEA or British citizens.

Immigration status



- 27 registrants (14%) stated that they don't know what a Criminal Records Bureau (CRB) Check is or entered no information, with 104 (53%) stating they had already been CRB checked in the past.

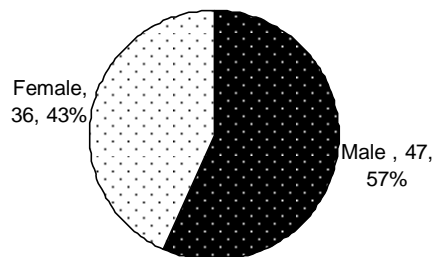
Criminal Records Bureau Check

- A total of 83 people (43%) are interested in teaching in the Primary Sector.
- 47 registrants are male.

Gender of Teachers Primary

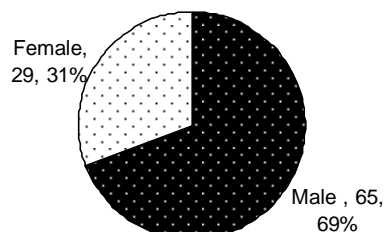


- 11 registrants hold an undergraduate and/or postgraduate degree as well as GCSE A*-C in Maths/English/Science or equivalent and have some school/teaching experience in the UK.
- 19 registrants hold a degree/postgraduate degree and have some school/teaching experience but do not hold GCSEs A*-C in Maths, English and Science.
- 28 registrants hold an undergraduate and/or postgraduate degree but have no GCSE A*-C in Maths/English/Science and have no school/teaching experience.

Secondary Sector Data

- 94 people (48%) are interested in teaching in the Secondary Sector.
- 69% of those interested in the secondary sector are male.

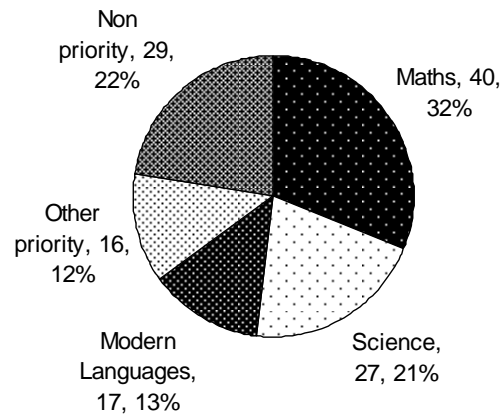


- 26 registrants hold an undergraduate and/or postgraduate degree as well as GCSE A*-C in Maths and English or equivalent and have some school/teaching experience in the UK.
- 25 registrants hold a degree/postgraduate degree and have some school/teaching experience but do not hold GCSEs A*-C in Maths and English.
- 41 registrants hold an undergraduate and/or postgraduate degree but have no GCSE A*-C in Maths/English/Science and have no school/teaching experience.
- 40 out of the 94 registrants (32%) would like to teach Maths
- 7 (21%) would like to teach Science
- 17 (13%) are interested in teaching Modern Languages¹
- 16 (12%) registrants wish to teach other priority subjects².
